Stock Antique Tractor Pull Rules

Weight Classes

4500#, 5500#, 6500#

Rules

All drivers must be able to control all controls of the tractor from the driver's seat. All minors must submit written consent of parents or guardian to enter the contest. Such a statement must be turned in at the time of entry. Each contestant enters the contest at his/her own risk or that of the parent/guardian and recognizes that he/she may be held responsible for any accident or injury incurred or property damage to others caused by him/her or his/her tractor. Upon entry each driver agrees to release all officials from responsibility or claim for any liability.

- **1959 and older** through production years
- **AGE:** Drivers less than 18 years of age must have written parental/guardian permission. No one under 14. Permission slips available at time of registration.
- **1st or 2nd gear** only with no shifting
- **3 mph speed limit:** Driver will be allowed to beep the horn up to 150 feet (cone), if horn beeps after cone the driver is disqualified..
- Driver is allowed **two attempts** within fifty feet to start the sled.
- **18" maximum drawbar height** - 18" minimum drawbar length center axle to hook
- **Hitches:** All 3-point and fast hitch style must be **locked at 18" or less**. Must hook to factory draw bar that hooks to the belly of the tractor. (International/M/H) **No modified hitches.**
- **Drawbars must be stationary** in all directions and have clevis or 3" hitch opening
- **Stock engines and stock RPM's only/with stock carburetor and ignition system.** (No MSD or other electronic ignition systems or hot coils.) Alternators and straight exhaust pipes will be allowed.
- **2 wheel drive only** - No duals
- **No cut or sharpened tires**
- **Factory wheel weights only.** (Bolt-on type from factory will be allowed, either front or rear weights) - No hanging weights or weight brackets.
- **Weigh out and measure drawbar** after pull
- **Only pull officials are allowed on the track**
- All pulls must be **started with a tight chain, no jerking**
- **Disqualification:** Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
- Must have **working brakes**
- Must keep **one hand on the steering wheel at all times**
- Tractors only allowed one hook per class/**no double entries**
- Tractor must **stay inside boundaries** at all times
- Must attend driver's meeting. Pullers must **obey flagmen**
- All pull **committee decisions are final**
- **Kill switches and wheel bars** suggested
- **NO ONE** under influence of **drugs or alcohol** will be permitted to participate or compete.
- **SAFETY:** Front wheels of tractor may not exceed 16" off the ground during pull.

Semi Modified Tractor Pull Rules

Weight Classes

3750#, 4000#, 4500#, 5500#, 6500#, 7500#

Rules

All drivers must be able to control all controls of the tractor from the driver's seat. All minors must submit written consent of parents or guardian to enter the contest. Such a statement must be turned in at the time of entry. Each contestant enters the contest at his/her own risk or that of the parent/guardian and recognizes that he/she may be held responsible for any accident or injury incurred or property damage to others caused by him/her or his/her tractor. Upon entry each driver agrees to release all officials from responsibility or claim for any liability.

- **1959 and older** through production years.
- AGE: Drivers **less than 18 years** of age must have **written parental/guardian permission. NO one under 14.** Permission slips available at time of registration.
- **Any gear** and use of torque amplifiers and automatic shifts
- **5 mph speed limit:** Driver will be allowed to beep the horn up to 150 feet (cone), if horn beeps after the cone, driver is disqualified.
- Driver is allowed **two attempts** within fifty feet to start the sled.
- **20" maximum drawbar height** – 18" minimum drawbar length center axle to hook
- **Drawbars must be stationary** in all directions and 3" hitch opening.
- **Stock engine with performance air cleaner, fuel pumps, alternators and no more than 10% factory high idle rpm OR 3250 rpm high idle with a SFI Scatter blanket.**
- **2 wheel drive only** – No duals
- **Cut or sharpened tires allowed. No tire larger than 18.4x38 any rim width**
- **Hanging weights and brackets allowed**
- **Weigh out and measure drawbar after pull**
- **Only pull officials are allowed on the track**
- All pulls must be **started with a tight chain, no jerking**
- **Disqualification:** Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
- Must have **working brakes**
- Must keep **one hand on the steering wheel at all times**
- Tractors only allowed one hook per class/**no double entries**
- Tractor must **stay inside boundaries** at all times
- Must attend driver's meeting. Pullers must **obey flagmen**

Each contestant enters the contest at his/her own risk or that of the parent/guardian and recognizes that he/she may be held responsible for any accident or injury incurred or property damage to others caused by him/her or his/her tractor. Upon entry each driver agrees to release all officials from responsibility or claim for any liability.

- AGE: Drivers **less than 18 years** of age must have **written parental/guardian permission. NO one under 14.** Permission slips available at time of registration.
- **Any gear** and use of torque amplifiers and automatic shifts
- **6 mph speed limit:** Driver will be allowed to beep the horn up to 150 feet (cone), if horn beeps after the cone, driver is disqualified.
- Driver is allowed **two attempts** within fifty feet to start the sled.
- **20" maximum drawbar height** – 18" minimum drawbar length center axle to hook
- **Drawbars must be stationary** in all directions and 3" hitch opening.
- **Stock block or a factory replacement. With stock injection pump. Tractor cannot be more than 10% over factory high rpm.**
- **2 wheel drive only** – No duals
- **No Cut or sharpened tires allowed.** Tire size will be no larger than 18.4x38 for 7500#,9000# and no larger than 20.8x38 or 18.4x42 for the 10500#, 12000#
- **Hanging weights and brackets allowed**
- **Weigh out and measure** drawbar after pull
- **Only pull officials are allowed on the track**
- All pulls must be **started with a tight chain, no jerking**
- **Disqualification:** Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
- Must have **working brakes**
- Must keep **one hand on the steering wheel at all times**
- Tractors only allowed one hook per class/**no double entries**
- Tractor must **stay inside boundaries** at all times
- Must attend driver's meeting. Pullers must **obey flagmen**
- All pull **committee decisions are final**
- **Kill switches and wheel bars** suggested

Modified Farm Stock Tractor Pull Rules

Weight Classes

7500# 9000# 12000#

Rules

All drivers must be able to control all controls of the tractor from the driver's seat. All minors must submit written consent of parents or guardian to enter the contest. Such a statement must be turned in at the time of entry. Each contestant enters the contest at his/her own risk or that of the parent/guardian and recognizes that he/she may be held responsible for any accident or injury incurred or property damage to others caused by him/her or his/her tractor. Upon entry each driver agrees to release all officials from responsibility or claim for any liability.

- **AGE:** Driver no one under 18 years old.
- **Any gear** and use of torque amplifiers and automatic shifts.
- **15 mph speed limit:** Driver will be allowed to beep the horn up to 150 feet (cone), if horn beeps after the cone driver is disqualified.
- Driver is allowed **two attempts** within fifty feet to start the sled.
- **20" maximum drawbar height** – 18" minimum drawbar length center axle to hook
- **Drawbars must be stationary** in all directions and 3" hitch opening
- **Tractors must be equipped with hood, grill and fenders, and retain stock appearance.**
- **Gas and LP tractors must use carburetor, diesels one turbo.**
- **Tractors must have stock block, stock heads, stock manifolds or their replacements are to remain unchanged in outside appearance. RPM max 3250 at high idle with a SFI Scatter blanket required 14" min. width.**
- **2 wheel drive only - No duals**
- **Cut or sharpened tires allowed. Tire size no larger than 24.5 x 32**
- **Hanging weights and brackets allowed**
- **Weigh out and measure drawbar after pull**
- **Only pull officials are allowed on the track**
- **All pulls must be started with a tight chain, no jerking**
- **Disqualification:** Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
- **Must have working brakes**
- **Must keep one hand on the steering wheel at all times**
- **Tractors only allowed one hook per class/no double entries**
- **Tractor must stay inside boundaries at all times**
- **Must attend driver's meeting. Pullers must obey flagmen**
- **All pull committee decisions are final**
- **Kill switches and wheel bars required.**
- **NO ONE** under influence of **drugs or alcohol** will be permitted to participate or compete.
